



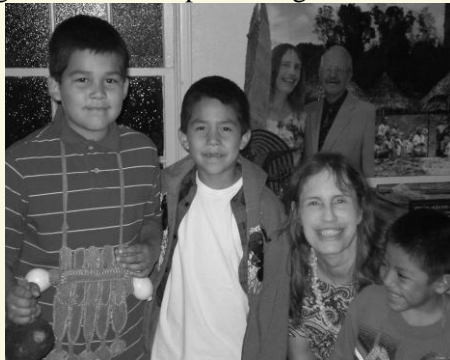
Muldoon's Monologue
